Help needed

Finance

You don't need to be a finance whizz-kid or have any specific finance qualification. We're just looking for someone who has some experience of financial admin, and is able to spend perhaps an hour a week "shadowing" Mike for the next few months, and then half-a-day or up to a day a week as Treasurer starting from our 2023 AGM.

Web development

Our current website (<https://www.psychotherapyandcounsellingunion.co.uk/>) has served our needs up to now, but it's increasingly failing to keep up with what we need to support our growth and development as a union.

We have recognised that this can't be fixed by a few minor adjustments, particularly because the current site is built on the Wix platform, which has turned out to be unsuitable for our developing requirements. And so we have decided to undertake a complete redevelopment of our website, using a more suitable platform such as WordPress, and also migrating to a different (shorter!) domain name.

We could pay thousands of pounds to a web design agency to do this work, but if possible we would prefer to do it ourselves, so that we can retain control of development and updating, rather than having to liaise with (and pay) an agency whenever we need something new.

However, this is not a job that should rest on the shoulders of any one individual member of PCU. What we need is a small team of people who can share the decision-making and the development work, so that nobody needs to do more than they are comfortable with.
